





## **Education: Outcomes**

- New Ireland Province introduced Free and Subsidised Education in 2008 the first province in PNG to do so.
- Over the five years Free and Subsidised Education has been in effect the parents of New Ireland Students have saved nearly K70 million they did not have to spend on school fees.
- National Government has finally adopted the New Ireland approach and is now implementing Free and Subsidised Education nationally.
- New Ireland has now taken the next step and made all education through grade 12 free, doubled the allowance for tertiary students from K1200 to K2500 and expanded postgraduate scholarships. We provide rations for all boarding students.


New Ireland is now making school attendance compulsory.

## Education: Outcomes

## New Ireland Children have Greatly Expanded Educational Opportunities Today

- In 2007 there was one secondary school in the Province – Namatanai Secondary School, accommodating about 400 Students.
- Today there are *six secondary schools* in the Province, with room for over 4000 students.
- Today there are four new high schools at Nasko, Tanga, Konomatalik and Boliu– offering additional places to New Ireland Students.
- New Ireland is the only province that has an high school or secondary school in every LLG





Figure 1: Impact Assessment Timeline
